Dances in $3 / 2$ or $3 / 4$ time have 3 steps to each bar of music. All other dances have 2 steps to the bar.

Dates given represent the dates or range of dates for original publication of the dance. More recently composed dances include the choreographer's name followed by the date of the dance.

## Dance Description Conventions

Unless otherwise indicated:
; = the midpoint of the music
Turn = 2-hand turn, once round
Circle $=$ circle left, once round
Cross = change sides of set by right shoulder, face out
Change = change sides by right shoulder, face back in
$\mathbf{C W}=$ clockwise
$\mathbf{C C W}=$ counter-clockwise
Circular hey is without hands
$\mathbf{L}=$ left
Left file = when facing across the set, those whose left shoulders are nearer the stage
$\mathbf{R}=$ right
Right file = when facing across the set, those whose right shoulders are nearer the stage
Right/Left shoulder siding $=$ meet $\mathrm{R} / \mathrm{L}$ shoulder, fall back
Right shoulder around = turn without hands, "holding" eyes
Rights \& lefts is with hands
Side = swirly siding (over by the left and back by the right)

## Double $V_{\text {isit }}$

Duple minor improper longways mixer, $6 / 8$ Philippe Callens, 1999
Music: "Captain Tom," published Walsh, 1711
A1 1-4 All lead up a double \& fall back
5-8 All set and change with partner
A2 1-4 All lead down a double \& fall back
5-8 All set and change with partner
B 1-4 Take hands in line, all fall back a double; dance forward a double
5-8 All dance back-to-back with partner
9-10 All set to partner
11-12 All side with partner
13-18 All R-hand turn with partner, then all progress one place CW along the set (dancers at end progress to opposite side)


## First String

2-couple longways set, 6/8
Loretta Holz, 2011
Music: "The Gates of Heck" by Dave Wiesler
A1 1-4 All lead up a double \& fall back; set to partner and turn 2 hands $1 / 2$ way
A2 5-8 All lead down a double \& fall back; set to partner and turn $C C W 2$ hands $1 / 2$ way

Chorus:
B1 1-2 1st corners L-hand turn 3/4 (take partner's R hand to make diagonal line)
3-4 Balance the line
5-6 All R-hand turn $1 / 2$ with partner
7-8 Leading corners followed by partner chase two places CW (following dancers finish chase where they began it, and all are progressed)

Continued...

B2 1-8 That again from these places, thus:
1-2 Dancers on 1st diagonal L-hand turn 3/4 (take partner's R hand to make diagonal line)
3-4 Balance the line
5-6 All R-hand turn $1 / 2$ with partner
7-8 Leading corners, followed by partner, chase two places CW (following dancers finish chase where they began it; and all are home)
A3 1-4 All R-shoulder siding with partner; set to partner and turn 2 hands $1 / 2$ way
A4 5-8 All L-shoulder siding with partner; set to partner and turn $C C W 2$ hands $1 / 2$ way
Chorus
A5 1-4 All arm R with partner; set to partner and turn 2 hands $1 / 2$ way
A6 5-8 All arm L with partner; set to partner and turn $C C W 2$ hands $1 / 2$ way

# Gigue for Genny 

3 -couple longways set, 6/8
Dan Herr, 1975
for Genny Shimer
Music: "Greenholm," traditional
A1 1-4 1s R-hand turn
5-8 1s long cast as 2 dance up
A2 skipping contra corners, thus:
1 1s pull by R
2-4 1s turn 1st corner by L
$5 \quad 1 \mathrm{~s} \mathrm{R}$-hand turn 1/2
6-8 1 s turn 2 nd corner by $\mathrm{L}, 1 \mathrm{~s}$ cross $(\mathrm{L})$ to middle of own side to begin...
B1 1-8 L shoulder hey for 3 on own side (1s finish in middle place)
B2 1-4 All R-hand turn with partner
5-6 2 s at top set while bottom R diagonal change
7-8 2s turn single R while bottom 4 cast 1 place CW around foursome (finish in order 2-3-1)


## Heartfelt

> Duple minor longways, 3/4
> Jenna Simpson, 2020
> Music: "22 More" by Dave Wiesler

A 1-2 1s R-hand turn 3/4 and retain hands while 2 s take 2 small side steps up to form a diamond
3-4 1s balance to each other
5-8 1s pass $R$ shoulder, loop $R$ around standing $2 s$ to end in starting place in diamond formation
B 1-2 All join hands, balance the diamond
3-4 All petronella turn 1 place CCW (1s end on sidelines, 2 s in middle)
5-8 2s pass R shoulder, loop R around standing 1 s , dance through starting place in diamond to face original corner, ready for...
C 1-6 Dance 6 changes of L-shoulder hey, end in line of 4 facing up ( 1 s in the middle, 2 s on the end, all on opposite of original side)
7-8 Line of 4 dance up 6 steps
D 1-2 Line of 4 fall back, bend into a ring 3-4 All circle L $1 / 2$, open to sidelines
5-8 Partners start: 3 changes of circular hey

## Hudson Barn

Duple minor longways, 3/4
Jacqueline Schwab and Charles Hammond, 1974
Music: "Dance to Your Daddy," traditional
A1 1-4 All circle
5-6 All L-hand star 1/2
7-8 1st corners cross-hand turn CCW $11 / 2$
B1 1-4 All circle R
5-6 All R-hand star 1/2
7-8 2nd corners cross-hand turn CW $11 / 2$ (all progressed and on opposite side)
A2 1-4 All dance back-to-back with neighbor
5-6 All handy hand turn $1 / 2$ with neighbor (1s up outside)
$7-8$ 1s $1 / 2$ figure 8 down through 2s
B2 1-2 1 s lead down, turn alone
3-4 1s lead up
5-8 1s cast to 2nd place and turn while 2 s turn $11 / 2$ as they move up the set


## Jack's Health

Duple minor longways, 6/8
Dancing Master I, 1679-1728
Music: "Bolt the Door"
A1 1-4 1s cross R shoulder and dance down to 2nd place as 2 s dance up
5-8 1s turn, end on partner's side
A2 1-4 All dance back-to-back with neighbor
5-8 All fall back a double with neighbor; set
B1 1-4 All dance forward, turn single cloverleaf (1s down, 2 s up)
5-8 Partners start: 2 changes rights \& lefts
B2 1-4 2 more changes rights \& lefts
5-8 All turn partner to end on own side of dance ( 1 s once and a half, 2 s once)


## Lovers' Knot

Duple minor improper longways, 6/8 Jim Kitch, 1986
Music: "Indian Point" by Rick Mohr
A1 1-4 Double Mad Robin CW, 1st corners slide R in front of neighbor to begin
5-8 $1 / 2$ poussette CW , 1 st corners dance forward to begin
A2 1-4 All circle L 3/4
5-8 All turn partner $11 / 2$ on the side
B1 1-8 Full hey for 4 , pass $L$ shoulder on 1st corner to begin
B2 1-4 All R-shoulder around with partner on the side
5-8 Those on 1st corner start L-hand star 3/4; others fall in behind partner

## Mary K

Duple minor improper longways, $3 / 2$
Gary Roodman, 2003
Music: "Scherzo in C minor" by Dave Wiesler 1999

A1 1-3 2nd corners cast R around neighbor to other corner's place
4 All turn partner 1/2 on the side
A2 1-3 Those now on 2nd diagonal cast R around partner to other corner's place
4 All turn neighbor $1 / 2$ on the side
B1 1-2 All circle L $1 / 2$; fall back with neighbor 3-4 All cross R shoulder with partner; loop R to face across to partner
B2 1-2 Partners start: 2 changes rights \& lefts
3-4 All turn partner (1s now face up, 2s face partner; all progressed and on original side)
C "Petits Fours" thus (dance strongly with crisp pivots on the 3 rd beat of each measure):
1-2 1s lead up, fall away to side while 2s fall back and dance down
3-4 1s dance down outside and lead in to meet while 2 s meet and lead up
5-6 1s dance down through next neighbors and fall away to side while 2 s fall back and dance up around next neighbors
7-8 1 s dance up outside and lead in to meet while 2 s meet and lead down

## Michedonia

## Duple minor longways, $2 / 2$ <br> Dan Blim, 2014 <br> Music: "Hora ca la Caval," traditional

A1 1-4 1 s cast down and set as 2 s dance up
5-8 1s 1/2 figure 8 up through 2s
A2 1-4 Repeat from these places: 2 s cast down and set as 1s dance up
5-8 2s $1 / 2$ figure 8 up through 1s
B1 1-2 2nd diagonals change $R$ shoulder
3-4 Turn partner $1 / 2$ on the side
5-6 Those now on 2nd diagonals change R shoulder
7-8 Turn neighbor $1 / 2$ on the side
B2 1-4 All circle
5-8 All turn partner


# Mister|saac's Maggot 

Duple minor longways, 3/2
Dancing Master I, 1695

## A1 1-2 1 st corners R-hand turn 1/2 <br> 3-4 Original top corner continue CW arc, dance outside of set behind neighbor back to place while other corner dance inside set back to place

A2 1-2 2 nd corners L-hand turn 1/2
3-4 Original top corner continue CCW arc, dance outside of set behind neighbor back to place while other corner dance inside set back to place (all end close to partner)
B 1-2 All fall back with neighbor
3 All dance toward partner
4 All turn single R
5-6 Partners start: 2 changes circular hey
7-8 Pass partner R shoulder to end in line of 4 facing up, 1 s in the middle and 2 s on the end
9-10 Line of 4 lead up a double \& fall back
11-12 2s gate 1 s up and around

## Money Musk

Triple minor longways, $2 / 2$
Music by Daniel Dow, 1776
A1 1-4 1s R-hand turn 1 1/2
A2 $\quad 1-2 \quad 1 \mathrm{~s}$ cast down to 2 nd place as 2 s dance up
3-4 Lines of 3 on the side balance
B1 1-4 1s R-hand turn $3 / 4$; fall into lines of 3 across the dance
B2 1-2 Balance the line 3-4 1s R-hand turn 3/4
C 1-4 2 s and 1 s right and left through, no hands (in shoulder-to-shoulder courtesy turn, dancer on the left dances backward) 5-8 That again


## The Old Batchelor

Duple minor longways, 6/8
Dancing Master I; Walsh, 1718-1760
A1 1-4 1 s cross, dance down, and meet in the middle of a line of 4 , facing up
5-8 Line of 4 lead up a double \& fall back
A2 1-4 Side with neighbor (1s pull back $R$ shoulder to face partner)
5-8 $\quad 1$ s turn $11 / 4$ (end with original R-file dancer above)
B $\quad 1-2 \quad 1 \mathrm{~s}$ open to include 2 nd R-file dancer, circle 4 steps
3-6 1st R-file dancer open to include remaining dancer, circle until 1s are above
7-8 All turn single $R$
9-10 Partners start: 2 changes of a circular hey
11-12 1 s change by $R$ shoulder to own side

 to Glen Echo4-couple square set mixer, $2 / 2$
Melissa Running, 2011, revised 2023
Music: Melissa Running
A1 1-4 Heads: Partners start 2 changes rights \& lefts (retain L hand after 2nd change to face out nearest side)
5-8 Heads dance $1 / 2$ figure 8 through side couples to end in partner's original place
A2 1-4 Sides: Partners start 2 changes rights \& lefts (retain $L$ hand after 2nd change to face out nearest side)
5-8 Sides dance $1 / 2$ figure 8 through head couples to end in partner's original place
B1 1-8 Grand square (sides face to begin)
B2 1-4 All join hands and lead in with current partner; fall back with new partner
5-8 All turn new partner, moving to L-hand dancer's home place ( $1 / 8$ of circle CW)

## Portsmouth

Duple minor longways, $2 / 2$ Dancing Master I, 1701

A1 1-8 1 st corners pass $R$ shoulder to begin full hey for three on the R file
A2 1-8 2nd corners pass $L$ shoulder to begin full hey for three on the L file
B1 1-4 $\quad 1 \mathrm{~s}$ cross and dance down to 2 nd place as 2 s dance up
5-8 1s $1 / 2$ figure 8 up through 2s
B2 1-8 Partners start: 4 changes of rights \& lefts


## SaltySweet

Duple minor longways, $2 / 2$
Anna Rain, 2018
Music: "Umami" by Dave Wiesler
A 1-4 All R-hand turn $1 / 2$ with neighbor; balance
5-6 1st corner diagonals cross
7-8 Those dancers hold that place, draw partner to face them and take 2 hands
9-12 Half poussette CW
13-16 Balance with partner; 2s cast down while 1s dance up (all home)
B 1-8 "Interrupted $1 / 2$ double figure 8" thus:
1-2 1 s cast down while 2 s cross up (pass L shoulder and keep eye contact), all face partner
3-4 All balance to partner (no hands)
5-6 2 s cast down while 1 s cross up (pass L shoulder and keep eye contact), all face partner
7-8 All balance to partner (no hands)
9-12 All R-hand star $1 / 2$; turn single L
13-16 All L-hand star

## Swept Away

Duple minor longways, $2 / 2$ Jenny Beer, 2023
Music: "Bruce Hamilton's Broomstick" by Dave Marcus

A 1-8 All dance up a double \& back; all dance down a double \& back (stay facing down)
B 1-4 2 s cast up and lead down while 1s lead down and cast up (end facing previous neighbors)
5-8 With previous neighbors: 2 s dance down outside and lead up while 1s lead up and cast down (face original neighbor)
C 1-8 All set to neighbor, turn single R; all circle
D 1-4 2nd corners change R shoulder; 1st corners change R shoulder
5-8 All turn partner 1 1/2 (optional crossed hands)

## Up With Aily

Duple minor longways, $3 / 2$
Dancing Master I, 1651-1690
Music: "Hare's Maggot," Dancing Master I, 1701-1728

A1 1 Form line of three: Top L-file dancer receives dancers on either side
2-3 Line of 3 dance forward for $3 \&$ fall back
4 End dancers retire to place
5-6 L-file dancers progress (top dancer cast and bottom dancer curve up) while R-file dancers turn single up (R)
A2 1 Form line of three: Top R-file dancer receives dancers on either side
2-3 Line of 3 dance forward for $3 \&$ fall back
4 End dancers retire to place
5-6 R-file dancers progress (top dancer cast and bottom dancer curve up) while L-file dancers turn single up (L); all progressed
B 1-4 1s dance back-to-back; 1s cast up as 2 s dance down
5-6 All circle
$7-81 \mathrm{~s}$ cast down (2s dance up)
